



Driver's Eligibility Certificate

**Please read and understand all information on this page before going to EWA's High School Office for your Driver's Eligibility Certificate or attempting to go to DMV for your Learner's Permit!*

Driver Eligibility Certificates are valid for **30 days** only. Please submit completed driver eligibility certificates to DMV before the 30-day deadline. If you know you are not going to DMV within 30 days or you are not going to be 15 years old within 30 days, please wait until you are ready to get your learner's permit before starting this process.

Students must pass 3 of 4 courses at East Wake Academy High School to obtain a validation seal on the driver eligibility certificate. If you fail **two or more courses** at East Wake Academy High School or you drop out of school before your 18th birthday you will not get your driver eligibility certificate validated and you will lose your driving privileges if you already have them.

*Appointment will only be scheduled on **Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday** of each week between 7:45-8:15 mornings or afterschool 3:30-4:00.*

During the summer, eligibility certificates will be acquired by appointment only. Email kcampbell@eastwakeacademy.org, to set up an appointment.

Please follow these steps in obtaining your Driver Eligibility Certificate:

1. After completing both the classroom and driving phases of driver education, parents will need to set up an appointment with the Admission Coordinator (*Mrs. Campbell 919-404-0444 ext. 1022*) to schedule a time to meet.

2. Parents, Acting Parents or Guardians are asked to bring to the scheduled meeting to acquire the Driver Eligibility Certificate: (A) your student's driver education certificate (B) a copy of your student's birth certificate

- You will be required to print your name, sign your name and date the upper portion of the driver eligibility certificate to make it official.
- You will receive your student's Drivers Eligibility Certificate and an official copy of their most recent report card or transcript.

Learners Permit: VERY IMPORTANT! Take the following items with you when going to get your Learners Permit: (A) your Driver Education Certificate (B) your parent signed Driving Eligibility Certificate (C) a copy of your birth certificate and (D) a copy of your most recently completed semester's report card or transcript. (E) Passport or Social Security card (D)Proof of Residency.
